#### MP2

- Simple Unix shell
- Built-in commands
  - Change directory
  - Termination

- Non built-in commands

### Read the command from stdin

• Let's look at 1.c

### Running Non Built-in Commands

- Requires a new process to run the binary
  - fork() creates a new process
  - exec() runs executable
  - wait () makes the parent wait for the child to finish

Instead of fork + exec + wait, we use system()
