1 Project Progress (40%)

2 Code Quality (40%)

- Use and integrate libraries appropriately.
- Good use of C++ style

3 Documentation (10%)

- Final proposal in PROPOSAL.md
- Development documentation in DEVELOPMENT.md

4 Presentation & Participation (10%)

- Present plan to finish on schedule
- Arrived on time with all necessary materials and ready to go
- Appropriate pacing and engagement of the fellow students
- Engaged and paying attention to other students presentations
