

ANNOUNCEMENT ON MIDTERM I

- The **First Test** will be held on **Tuesday, October 5, 7:00 - 8:30 pm, in Rm 165 Everitt Lab**. You are allowed to bring in one sheet of notes (both sides, if needed), but otherwise the *Test* will be closed-book and closed-notes. Laptops, calculators, palm-pilots, tables of integrals etc. will neither be necessary nor be permitted. Your one sheet can be hand-written, but the font size should not be too small, necessitating the use of a magnifying glass; as a general rule, any size smaller than the equivalent of a 10 pt font will not be permitted.
- The next two regularly scheduled office hours by the Teaching Assistants will be held as scheduled on Friday, October 1 (4:00 - 6:00 pm), and Tuesday, October 5 (3:00 - 5:00 pm). Parts of these office hours will serve as review sessions for the midterm; more precisely, 4:30 - 5:30 pm on Friday, and 3:30 - 4:30 pm on Tuesday. If you have any specific questions, then you should arrive at the beginning of the office hours or stay on after the review sessions.
- I will also hold my regular weekly office hour on Monday, October 4, 2:00 - 4:00 pm, to answer any questions you might have on the course material, and the four problem sets (and their solutions).
- As previously announced, there will be no class on Friday, October 1, but there **will** be regular class on Monday, October 4, when I will lecture on some new material.
- Homework set # 5 will be posted later in the week, with a due date of Wednesday, October 13.
- The test will cover the material included in the first four homework sets, chapters 1 through 4 of the text by Ross, and class lectures through today (Wednesday, September 29).
